The Leibniz Science Campus Ruhr will receive [funding by the Leibniz Association for another four years](#). We are delighted to be able to continue our successful work in the LSCR.

The [Essen Health Economics Seminar](#) has been running in virtual format for some time now and also the third [Essen Economics of Mental Health Workshop](#) will take place on August 03-04, 2020 in virtual format.

The paper "[Sources of regional variation in Health Care Utilization in Germany](#)" by Martin Salm and Ansgar Wübker published in the Journal of Health Economics won this year's "Wissenschaftspreis der deutschen Gesellschaft für Gesundheitsökonomie".
